Your containment system is a large capital investment that must be properly inspected and maintained. Standard material workmanship warranties for geosynthetics installations normally extend no further than one year from project completion. These warranties are pro rated and typically only cover a fraction of the replacement cost of the materials.



In response to many client's desires to protect their investment beyond the initial warranty period and help maintain their due diligence, Layfield is pleased to offer the Annual Service Package. It is recommended every 12 months of service and can be acquired for a period of 1, 3, or 5 years.

Established Safety Program

Layfield has full-time dedicated Safety Staff and follows a documented safety program for all aspects of our operations.
